

2022 Spectator Guide

The 45th Annual Assaults welcomes friends and family to cheer on their riders along the course! In order to make your experience more enjoyable, please note the following information.

How to Follow Your Rider

Per state and local laws, you will not be able to directly follow your rider. In order to maintain the safety of all riders, we suggest you follow this "spectators course" in order to cheer on riders.

Leave the Auditorium and get on I-85 South Take I-26 West Get off at Exit #5 for Hwy 11 Take a right on Hwy 11 Take a Left on Hwy 9 – **you will intersect with the course at mile 24.5** Stay straight on Hwy 9 after seeing your athlete Cross over Hwy 108 and head towards Lake Lure When you see the lake follow Hwy 64/74 – veer/turn right **You will intersect with your athlete at mile 46.2** Stay straight on Hwy 64/74 and turn then right on the 64/74 Bypass Look for signs for 221 North Go LEFT on 221 Bypass Take a LEFT on Hwy 70 Take a Left onto Resistoflex Rd. and then another Left into Tom Johnson's Campground **This will be mile 74.2**

At the campground, you can get on the spectator bus and go all the way to the top of Mt. Mitchell to meet your athlete. PLEASE NOTE: Spectator limitations may change due to COVID-19 restrictions and those changes will be communicated as they are determined.

Spectator Bus to the top of Mt. Mitchell

Due to safety concerns, family/friends/personal SAGS cannot drive to Mt. Mitchell. This is a policy set forth by the Blue Ridge Parkway and Mt. Mitchell State Park that we must adhere to.

If you would like to see your rider finish at the top of Mt. Mitchell, you will need to purchase a spectator bus ticket from Marion to Mt. Mitchell for \$15 at the ticket/information table or at

Marion on Monday (cash only) ... The bus ride is approximately 1 hour and 40 minutes. You will be allowed to return to Marion on the same bus as your rider.

Meal Tickets

You can enjoy lunch at Tom Johnson Campground with your rider by purchasing a meal ticket at the ticket/information table (during Packet Pickup - cash only) or at Marion on Monday (cash only). Tickets can be pre-purchased by the riders through their event registration.

Parking

There will be no personal SAGS, TECHS or any cars allowed to park along the route except for spaces listed under "Follow Your Rider." Those parked along the route will be moved by police, ride staff and parkway patrol. Any riders with a vehicle servicing them along the route will automatically be disqualified and will not be listed on final ride results.
